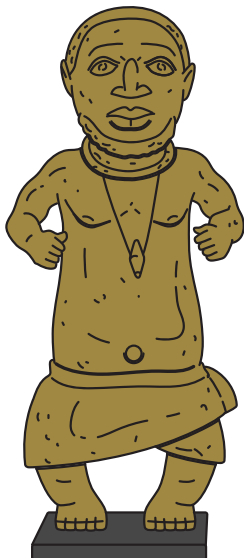

Eseiku (eseiku figures), according to oral tradition, have been identified as one group of the indigenous settlers of Benin, who were enclosed in a corner of the city, called Ivbioto today, while the new settlers, now referred to as the Benin people, took over the city. These figures depict individuals with the medical and genetic condition of dwarfism or chondrodysplasia.
