Ivin (carved coconut vessels) served as a medium for carvers who were part of the Emada and practised inside the palace. Ivin may have been used for storage or other functions. Some are cut in half, forming a bowl and a lid while others have small openings and lugs carved into the sides to allow them to be suspended, possibly to be used as a kind of flask.
